1. *Snake Hill & the Quassaick Creek*
Newburgh's southern boundary, the Quassaick is a hidden ecological gem. If you are looking for a view, none in the City are better than from the top of Snake Hill.
2. *Delano Hitch & the Armory*
The City's recreation center hosts Newburgh Newts baseball, and sports and recreation facilities for kids and adults alike.
3. *Broadway*
With sweeping Hudson views along one of the widest streets in New York, Broadway has food, entertainment, and culture. Italian bakeries, high-end Peruvian cuisine, tapas, tacos, or hot dogs at the lunch counter could fill up any hungry traveler. The Ritz theater, and the adjacent Cornerstone housing and gallery space offer art and culture inside, and out.
4. *The Heights*
Incredible views and a close-knit neighborhood of Victorian homes.
5. *Liberty St*
Washington's Headquarter's is surrounded by shops, cafes, and bistros along a beautifully restored historic street.
6. *Downing Park*
Newburgh's jewel, a gift by the designers of Central Park to the memory of their teacher AJ Downing and to the City where they began their careers together.
7. *the Newburgh Waterfront*
Waterfront dining at its best with marinas, a riverwalk, spas, and an art house theater.
8. *East End Historic District & Montgomery St*
One of the oldest and largest historic districts in the Country, take a stroll among examples of Newburgh's rich architectural past, and spend the night in one of the stately B&Bs.
